



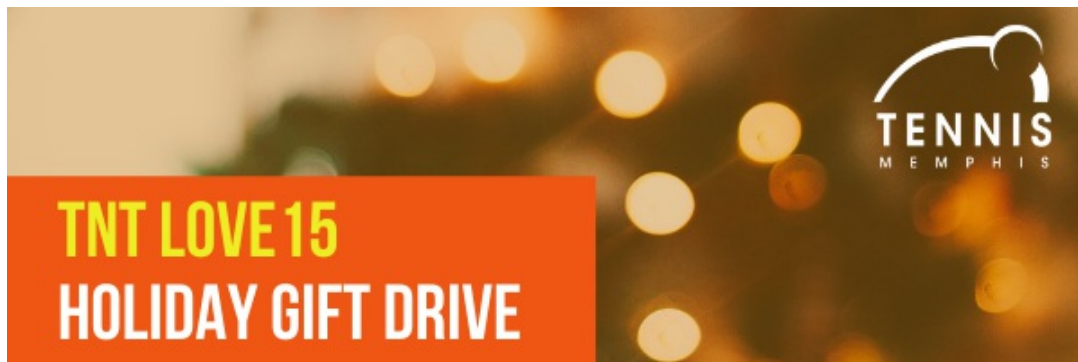
Help us SERVE our community by donating to Tennis Memphis

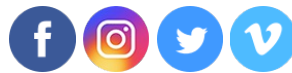
Junior Development (JD)
